<b>Location of Body at Discovery</b>	WB RR tracks approx. 500 ft. from west entrance to Santa Susana train tunnel unincorporated area near Corriganville Park.

<b>Details/Condition of Body at Discovery</b>	<p>Decedent nude body discovered near rr tracks. Victim shot multiple times w/large caliber gunshot wounds to torso. Significant head wound appears to have been caused by hatchet. Golf-style baseball cap found nearby with slice consistent with hatchet blow and brain matter inside hat. Body likely undressed and placed on rr tracks post mortem. Time and location of death undetermined at time of discovery by Vent Co deputies.</p> <p>Metrolink commuter train #115 struck body at approx. 13:40 hrs, reported by engineer. Suit with bloodstains and what appear to be gunshot holes found approx. 30 feet from body.</p> <p>Vintage postcards from “Glamis Castle” w/handwritten ref to “Somerset Belenoff” located with clothing. Decedent’s Argentinian passport in left breast pocket of suit jacket found nearby. 2 other bodies found at same location. See report refs 0518146 and 0518147. Photos of scene attached.</p>
